Remote Learning for Pupils Shielding/Self-Isolating who are well

Children and their families should still follow the tips and advice in the Parent & Child Remote Learning Information Handout Sept 2020

If a child is *shielding or self-isolating* then the class teacher and family support team will agree a remote learning plan to meet needs of the individual and family circumstances.

However, as the class teacher will still be in school teaching, children & parents are asked to use the guidance below to support their learning.

- 1. The teacher will direct children via Purple Mash 2email to specific lessons on**

- 2. They should also use their log in details to access the following at home**

- 3. Reading – Encourage your child to read for 20 mins each day – a book of their choice.**



- 4. CGP text workbooks can also be used by children and posted to children at home if they don't have them.**

Your child can still communicate through Purple Mash 2 email, email and phone with their class teacher as can parents.

They can post work on Purple Mash and the teacher can reply but unfortunately this will be limited due to their teaching commitment. Children will have sessions with their teacher over TEAMS. They will also be able to access assignments, post work and access TEAMS Chat to communicate with their teacher.
