

## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT FOR FEDERATED GOVERNING BOARDS

- (1) The name of the federation is **The Horsley and Mapperley Federation of Church of England Schools**
- (2) The names and categories of the schools in the federation are:

Name:	Category:
Horsley Church of England Primary School	Voluntary Controlled
Mapperley Church of England Voluntary Controlled Primary School	Voluntary Controlled

- (3) The name of the governing board is **‘The governing board of the Horsley and Mapperley Federation of Church of England Schools’**.
- (4) The governing board shall consist of:
- a. 2 Parent Governors (*elected across the federation*)
  - b. 1 Local Authority governor
  - c. 1 Staff Governor (*elected across the federation*)
  - c. 1 Executive Headteacher
  - e. 2 Foundation Governors
  - f. 7 Co-opted governors.
- (5) Total number of governors is 14
- (6) The appointment and removal of foundation governors shall be conducted as follows:
- (a) The Derby Diocesan Board of Education appoints two Foundation governors having regard to (but not being bound by) nominations received from St Clement’s Horsley Parochial Church Council and St Jude’s Mapperley Parochial Church Council (one nomination each).
  - (b) As the appointing body and in accordance with Regulation 20(1) of the Regulations, Derby Diocesan Board of Education may remove from office any foundation governor so appointed under paragraph 7(a).
- (7) Religious ethos of Horsley and Mapperley schools:
- Recognising their historic foundations, the schools will preserve their religious characters in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and Diocesan level.

The schools aim to serve their communities by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. They encourage an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promote Christian values through the experience they offer to all their pupils.

- (8) The trustees of Horsley school are the Derby Diocesan Board of Education. Mapperley school is held in a religious trust.
- (9) This Instrument of Government comes into effect on 1 September 2022, replacing the instruments made on 17 June 2015 (Horsley) and 12 February 2019 (Mapperley).
- (10) This Instrument was made by order of Derbyshire Local Authority on 29 June 2022.
- (11) A copy of the Instrument of Government must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor), the school's trustees and to the Diocesan Board of Education.
