Warmer Weather



In the summer terms it is important to make sure that your child is being sun safe. We recommend the following precautions;

Sun lotion

- Apply sun lotion at home before school.
- Send sun lotion into school. **Sun lotion must be designed for children.**
- Sun lotion must be labelled with your child's name and class, and inside a bag.
- Children must never share lotions.
- Children may 'top up' during the day but they will be expected to put the sun cream on themselves, with supervision from an adult. Only in exceptional circumstances will cream be put on for them. Please teach your child how to apply sun cream themselves especially on the face avoiding their eyes.

Water You can send in a named bottle of water for your child to keep in the classroom. Water fountains are available in school and in the playground too.

Hats Sun hats (especially legionnaire's style) are an extremely good idea. If your child is particularly prone to burning consider cool, long sleeve tops.

Shoes Please make sure your child is wearing sensible footwear for school. As you know the school has stairs around the building. For this reason, backless sandals (ie flip flops or similar) are not suitable for children in school.
